POLICY FOR FACILITIES FOR PHYSICALLY CHALLENGED STUDENTS

The vision and mission of the SSCP college of pharmacy realize/ think/ imagine that all human beings irrespective of differences in any form are treated fairly and providing equal opportunities to all. The college does not discriminate any students, parent or public on any aspect. The college takes care of the needs / additional requirements for the disabled students or their parents / guardians or visitors to the college,

The college has institutionalized the following policies for facilitating the students with Disabilities:

- > To give personal (individual) and professional (expert) counselling (Therapy), keeping in view of their special (exceptional) needs.
- > To motivate (support & give confidence) students with disabilities from rural background (surroundings) to pursue higher education.
- > Will not reject any admission on basis of being differently abled persons.
- > Communicate/ propagate/ circulate information regarding (concerning/about government or university orders (guidelines) dealing (commerce) with fee concessions, examination procedures, reservation, policies, etc., pertaining to differently abled persons.
- > Analyze/ evaluate the educational needs of differently abled persons admitted in the higher education institutions.
- > Analyze/ evaluate the ability of differently abled students and assist them in getting appropriate employment by providing special training skills.

Support System:

Support system allow/ permit people with disabilities to move about safely and freely and utilize the facilities within the campus. The disabled friendly support system provides an environment to disabled individuals and they can participate in everyday activities without anybody assistance. For this our college is supported with railings for their movement. Ramps are also provided in such way that a wheelchair user can use it without any difficulty. Wheel chair is also provided by the college.

Disabled friendly Washrooms:

Separate washrooms with western type and grab bars are arranged in the ground floor. Toilets with wide space and free movement of disabled students.

Scribes for Examination:

The college shall provide or allow scribes for those students who are in need of writing exams. In charge of Examinations shall allow the student on the recommendation of Principal to grant extra time to disabled candidates for answering papers at University examinations.

Extra time up to 20 mins per hour can be given to complete the answer paper. In case of students who are eligible for availing the services of scribes, the principal shall authorize to appoint scribes according to the following conditions.

- 1. The scribe shall not be an employee of the college/centre where the examination is conducted.
- 2. The scribe shall not be a relative of the student who is appearing for the examination.
- 3. The educational qualifications of the scribe shall be less than those of the student.

A pro forma with declaration in the format given by the college shall be obtained from the scribe. The pro forma signed by the scribe shall be forwarded to the college.

The Government of India has notified guidelines for evaluation of the disabilities and procedures to be adopted at Higher Educational Institutions. The college as per the guidelines of the government and that of the affiliating university will ensure that the disabled persons are encouraged.

Initiatives Taken to Implement the Clean and Green campus Policy

The SSCP is dedicated to handle its campus in accordance with its clean and green campus policy by establishing the following infrastructure activities

Rainwater Harvesting:

The college recognizes the importance of conservation and the best utilization of water resources. The college maintains and generates water resources. The college has a bore well to meet the general needs of the institution and encourages the recycling of RO water and rain water harvesting.

The water from the roof tops ie slabs along with the rain water is collected through a well connected pipes and delivery system. This arrangement is helpful in collecting water, which is then connected to pits, specially for this purpose.

The rain water stored in the pits is useful in the hot summer season, when water scarcity is more than the surrounding bore wells get recharged and the ground water level will be increased.

Landscaping with Trees and Plants:

The number of trees and plants within the campus create an eco friendly environment and impart a positive impact on the student's education. The college encouraging the students by participating in several plantation programmes. The college has a full time gardener to maintain and monitor the plants and medicinal plants. The corridors of the college are lined up with potted plants. College has a separate Medicinal Herbal Garden within the campus.

Ban on Single- Use Plastic:

The campus is plastic free zone campus. There is complete ban on single use plastics within the campus. Specially designed dust bins are provided to collect the plastic wastes. Students are participating in awareness programmes inside and outside the campus regarding ban on single use plastics. Hazards effects of use of plastics are explained to students intermittently by conducting seminars to develop plastic free zone within the campus.

Paperless Office and Communication:

The college has established policy to reduce the use of paper in all types off official/academic transactions in the college through E-Communication. The use of paper is minimized through digitalization. One-said blank papers are also used to avoid wastage of paper. All the college staff have been provided the college E-mail IDs and through which they have to carry official and college-related transactions. What's app — class-wise groups, Department wise groups, Committee wise groups have been formed which have reduced the usage of paper in notices boards and circulars. This practice has proved highly beneficial to save the paper use within the campus.

Energy Consumption

To minimize the consumption, the institute practices

- > Turn off the things when are not in use.
- Using LED light bulbs.
- > Use the fans only when they are needed.

> Keep lights off in conference rooms. Lecture halls when they are not in use

> Turn off unnecessary lights and utilize the day light instead.

Public Transport/ bus facility

The college provides bus facility to all its students and staff.

Restricted Entry of Automobiles
