

#### Rainwater Harvesting:


The college recognizes the importance of conservation and the best utilization of water resources. The college maintains and generates water resources. The college has a bore well to meet the general needs of the institution and encourages the recycling of RO water and rain water harvesting.

The water from the roof tops i.e. slabs along with the rain water is collected through a well-connected pipes and delivery system. This arrangement is helpful in collecting water, which is then connected to pits, especially for this purpose. The rain water stored in the pits is useful in the hot summer season, when water scarcity is more than the surrounding bore wells get recharged and the ground water level will be increased.




#### Landscaping with Trees and Plants:

The number of trees and plants within the campus create an ecofriendly environment and impart a positive impact on the student's education. The college encouraging the students by participating in several plantation programmes. The college has a full time gardener to maintain and monitor the plants and medicinal plants. The corridors of the college are lined up with potted plants. College has a separate Medicinal Herbal Garden within the campus.




#### Ban on Single- Use Plastic:

### Paperless Office and Communication:



- > Turn off unnecessary lights and utilize the day light instead.




## Public Transport/ bus facility

#### **Restricted Entry of Automobiles**
