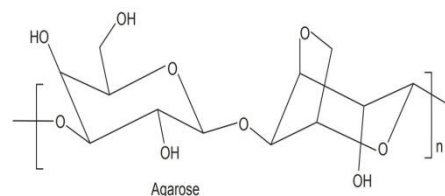

CHEMICAL CONSTITUENTS:

- ❖ Agar's heartwood is rich in essential oil, resins, alkaloids (liriodenine), saponins, steroids, terpenoids, tannins,
- ❖ Agar 7 flavonoids (aquisiflavoside, aquilarisin, aquilarisin, and aquilarixanthone), and phenolic compounds



USES:

- ❖ Helpful in increasing appetite
- ❖ Help to remove bad odor and bad breath
- ❖ Beneficial in diarrhea
- ❖ Able to reduce intestinal gas, inflammation and abdominal distensio
- ❖ Effective in fever
- ❖ Help to relieve fatigue and weakness after fever
- ❖ Beneficial in bronchitis
